

One Question Survey – Question Sets

By and large, the hardest part of sharing the gospel is getting into conversations that lead to the gospel. We may start conversations about the weather, dogs or music, but then we try to shift to spirituality, it can seem less than caring and even ingenuine.

We have seen that being upfront and asking simple but direct questions that are spiritual in nature are good avenues for stepping people toward a conversation about the gospel. Below are five survey questions or statements, and the follow up questions, that we have had success in getting into meaningful gospel conversations. The key to any of these conversations is to ask the questions, listen, respond appropriately and GENUINELY care as you guide the conversation toward the gospel.

How much grace do you need? Scale of 0-5

- *You may need to explain the concept of grace:*
 - o *Receiving something good that you don't deserve.*
 - *A teacher giving an extension on a project, or God offering us forgiveness even though we don't deserve it.*
- Why did you answer that way?
- If you could have a "5" would you want it?
- Can I share how the Bible teaches that you can have an infinite amount of grace from God?

Hope is powerful. Agree/Disagree

- Why do you agree/disagree with that?
- Have you ever put your hope in something that let you down?
- Can I share something I put my hope in that has never failed me?

How much peace do you have? Scale of 0-10

- Why did you answer that way?
- How about spiritually, would you say you have peace with God? Why?
- If you could have peace with God for eternity, would you want to know how to find it?

Saying "sorry" is enough? Agree/Disagree

- Why do you agree/disagree with that?
- Do you think it is possible to earn forgiveness?
- Is there anything that you've done that you should say "sorry" to God for?
- Can I share with you how I've received unearned forgiveness from God?

Is Jesus still relevant? Yes/No

- Why would you say that?
- Do you know why Jesus was put to death?
- Has anyone ever shared why the Bible says Jesus was relevant 2000 years ago and is still relevant today?
- * For Muslims I ask, "Has a Christian ever explained why Jesus is so important to our faith?"*

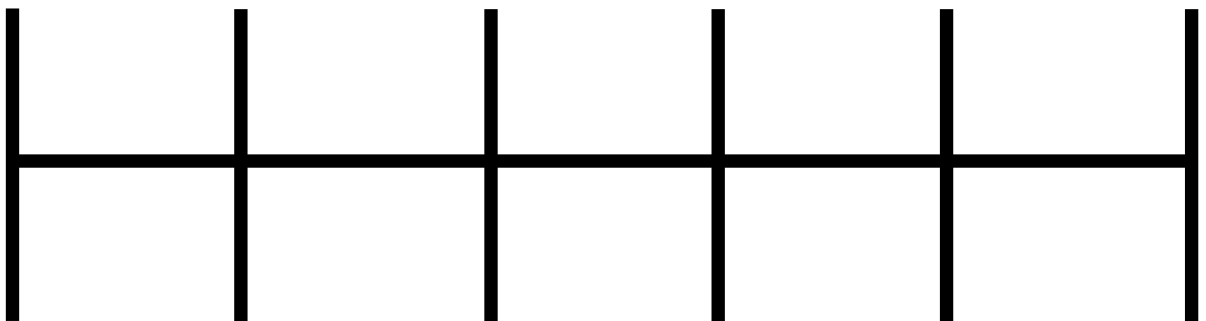

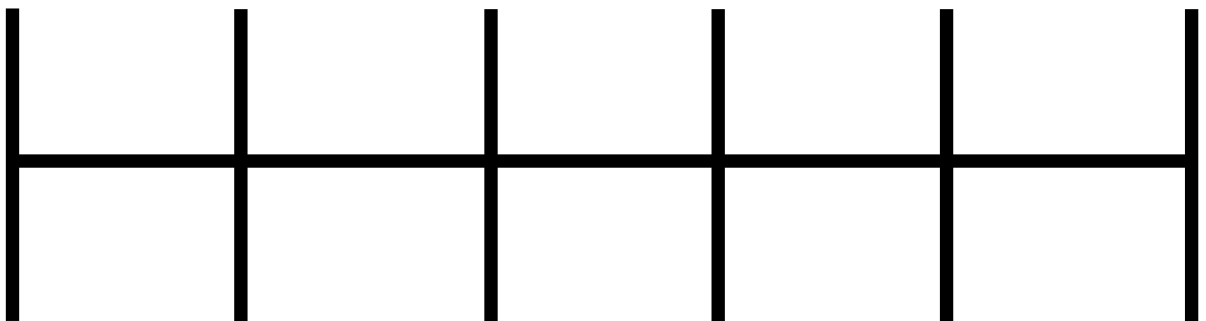
